

Discipline Plan:

In my classroom I will use a “Fix It” as my disciplinary plan. In this plan, students will recognize their behavior, state why the behavior occurred, and how they plan to fix it. I will write on the Fix It, quoting anything the students may say to me. I want the students to be involved in the process so they can think through their actions and brainstorm how to solve the issue without someone demanding them to act in a different way. They will need to sign the bottom, agreeing that they will implement this fix it to their behavior.

There will be a student/parent copy that will be sent home and asked to be signed and returned as well as a teacher copy that I will keep in my records. I will have a large binder where I keep all of my students’ information. Each student will have a separate folder with their name on it within the binder. This will help me locate any type of information I need, including a Fix It.
